SENIOR MANAGEMENT OF THE SECURITIES COMMISSION

The Commission's senior management team is led by the Executive Chairman, Datuk Ali Abdul Kadir who is assisted by the Deputy Chief Executive, Datin Zarinah Anwar. Apart from the Chairman and the Deputy Chief Executive, the senior management comprises the following directors:

SIOW KIM LUN

Siow Kim Lun is the director of the Market Supervision Division. This division carries out the supervisory function over market institutions and intermediaries and the licensing of intermediaries, conducts surveillance on all market activities as well as monitors compliance with accounting standards by PLCs.

SHARKAWI ALIS

Sharkawi is the director of the Corporate Resources Division. This division supports the daily operations through four departments, namely; Finance and Administration Department, Human Resources Department, Property and Facilities Management Department, and Security Department.

DR NIK RAMLAH NIK MAHMOOD

Dr Nik Ramlah is the director of the Market Policy and Development Division. This division is entrusted with a broad range of responsibilities in relation to regulatory policy, capital market development as well as education and training. These responsibilities range from instituting legal and regulatory reform to development of institutions, products and market infrastructure, including the development of the Islamic capital market and the bond market, overseeing development of IT infrastructure for the market, providing investor education as well as training programmes for all capital market professionals.

WONG WING SEONG

Wong Wing Seong is the director of the Issues and Investment Division. This division carries out the regulatory functions in relation to the issues/offerings/listing of securities, take-overs and mergers, assets valuation, and matters pertaining to unit trusts and other collective investment schemes.

RANJIT AJIT SINGH

Ranjit Singh is the director of the Strategy, Research and Corporate Affairs Division. This division is made up of four departments and is principally responsible for the Commission's strategic work; policy analysis and applied research in relation to economic, financial and accounting issues; as well as co-ordinating the Commission's international involvement, particularly work in relation to international financial regulation. The division is also responsible for external communications and corporate relations matters.

ABDUL KARIM ABDUL JALIL

Abdul Karim is the director of the Enforcement Division. This division discharges the enforcement powers of the Commission against activities that contravene the securities laws. There are three departments within this division, namely; Investigation Department, Prosecution Department, and Complaints Unit.
