#### SECURITIES INDUSTRY ACT 1983

SECURITIES INDUSTRY (REPORTING OF SUBSTANTIAL SHAREHOLDING)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2001

In exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 127(2)(p) of the Securities Industry Act 1983 [Act 280], the Minister makes the following regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Securities Industry (Reporting of Substantial Shareholding) (Amendment) Regulations 2001.
  - (2) These Regulations come into operation on 1 August 2001.

#### Amendment of regulation 7

- 2. The Securities Industry (Reporting of Substantial Shareholding) Regulations 1998 [P.U. (A) 174/98], which in these Regulations are referred to as the "principal Regulations", are amended in regulation 7—
  - (a) in subregulation (1), by substituting for the word "two" the word "five"; and
  - (b) in subregulation (2), by substituting for the words "two per centum" the words "five per centum".

# Deletion of regulation 7A

3. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 7A.

### Amendment of regulation 8

4. Subregulation 8(1) of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting for the words "in the form prescribed in Schedule 1" the words "in the manner provided under Division 3A of Part IV of the Companies Act 1965".

### Amendment of regulation 9

5. Subregulation 9(1) of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting for the words "in the form prescribed in Schedule 2" the words "in the manner provided under Division 3A of Part IV of the Companies Act 1965".

## Amendment of regulation 10

6. Subregulation 10(1) of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting for the words "in the form prescribed in Schedule 3" the words "in the manner provided under Division 3A of Part IV of the Companies Act 1965".

#### Deletion of Schedules 1, 2 and 3

7. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting Schedules 1, 2 and 3.
