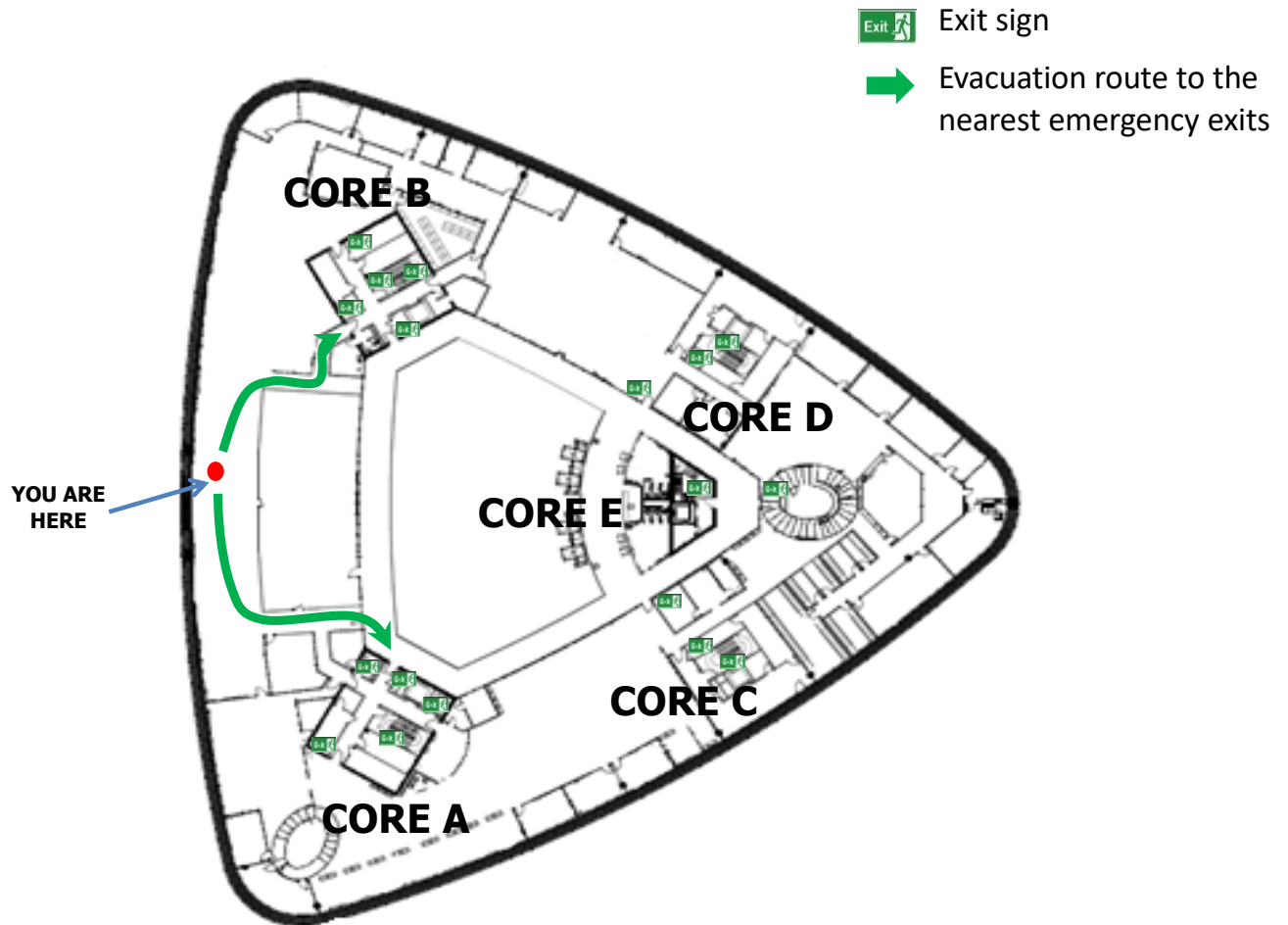


In Case of Emergency

(Office Area Core A – B, Level 4)



EVACUATION

- Upon hearing the fire alarm, wait for further instructions before commencing to leave the building.

- If the nearest exit is inaccessible, then move to the other alternative exits.
- Make your way to the emergency assembly area located at the open carpark of the National Science Centre.

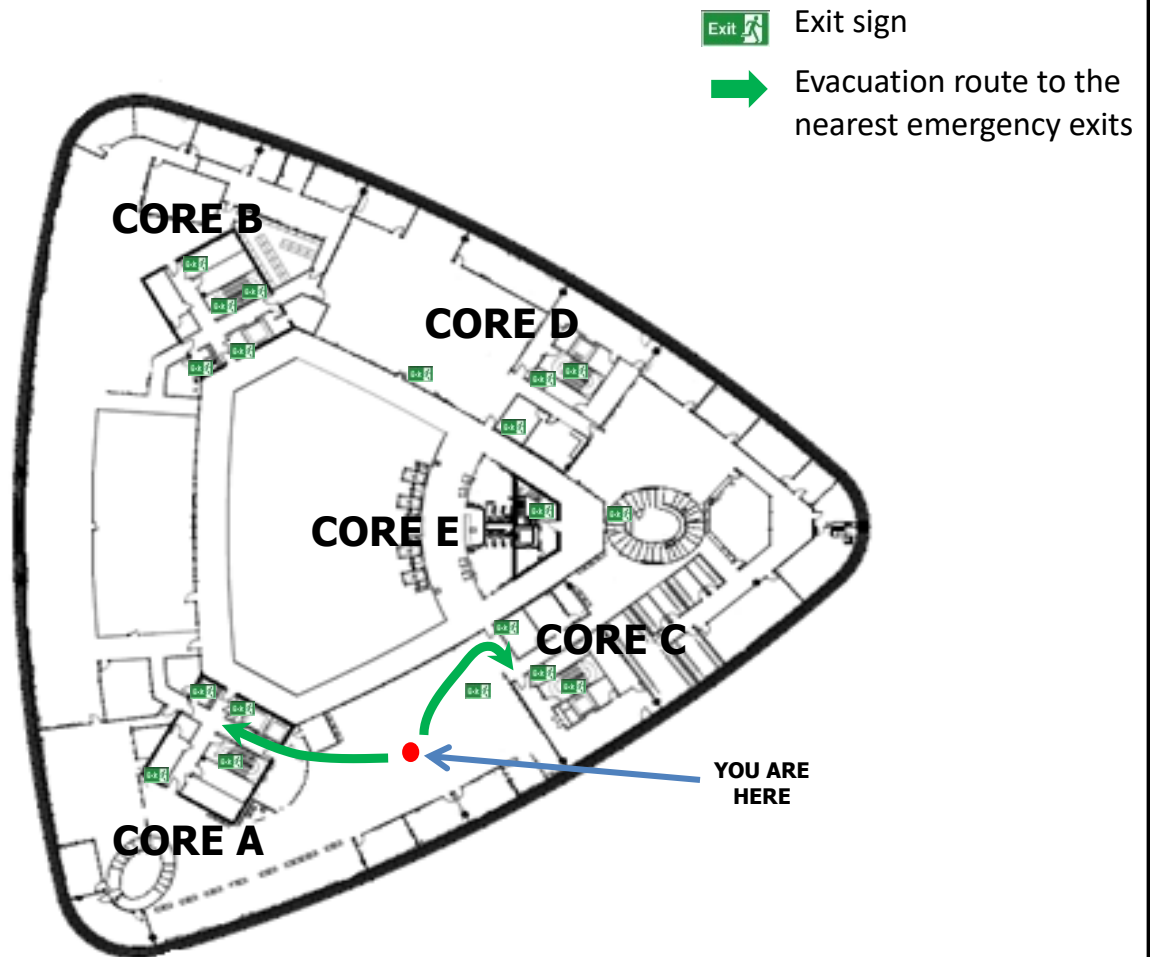

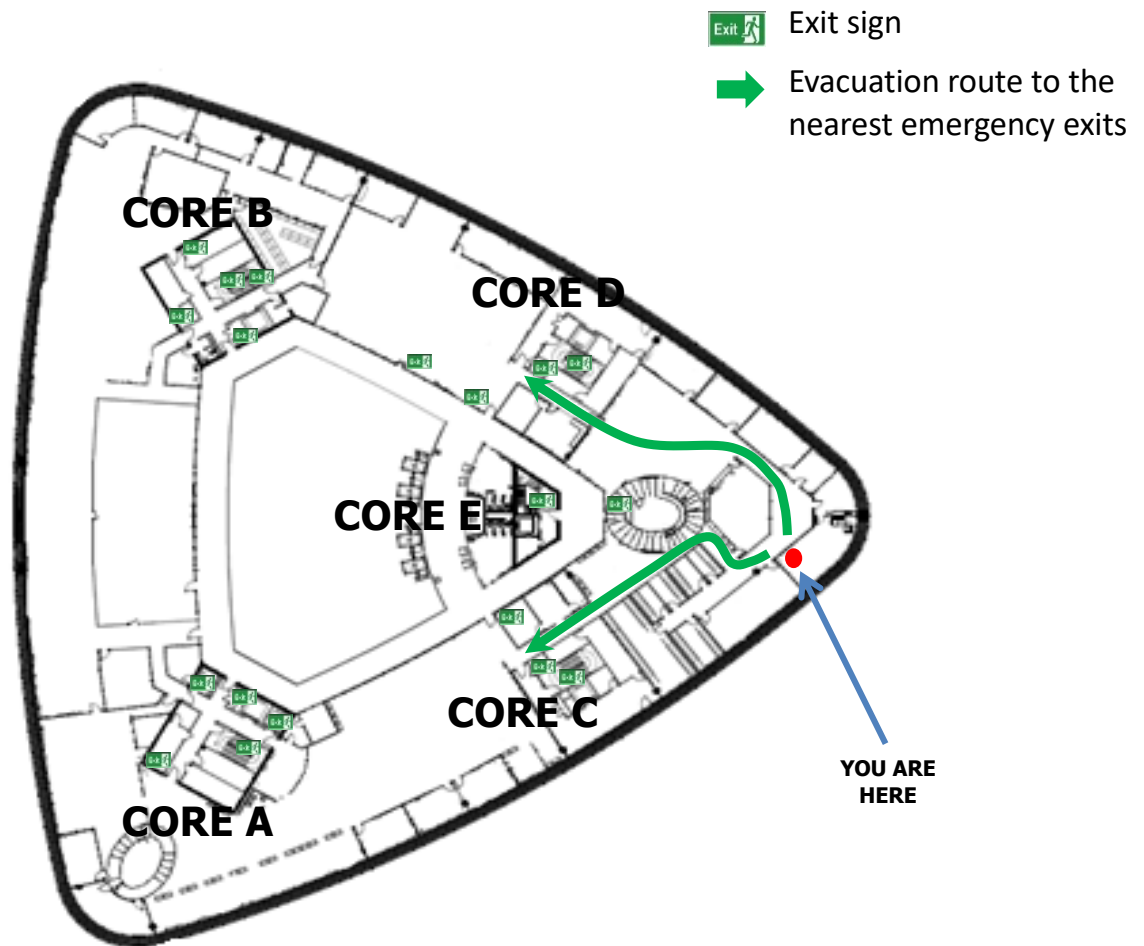

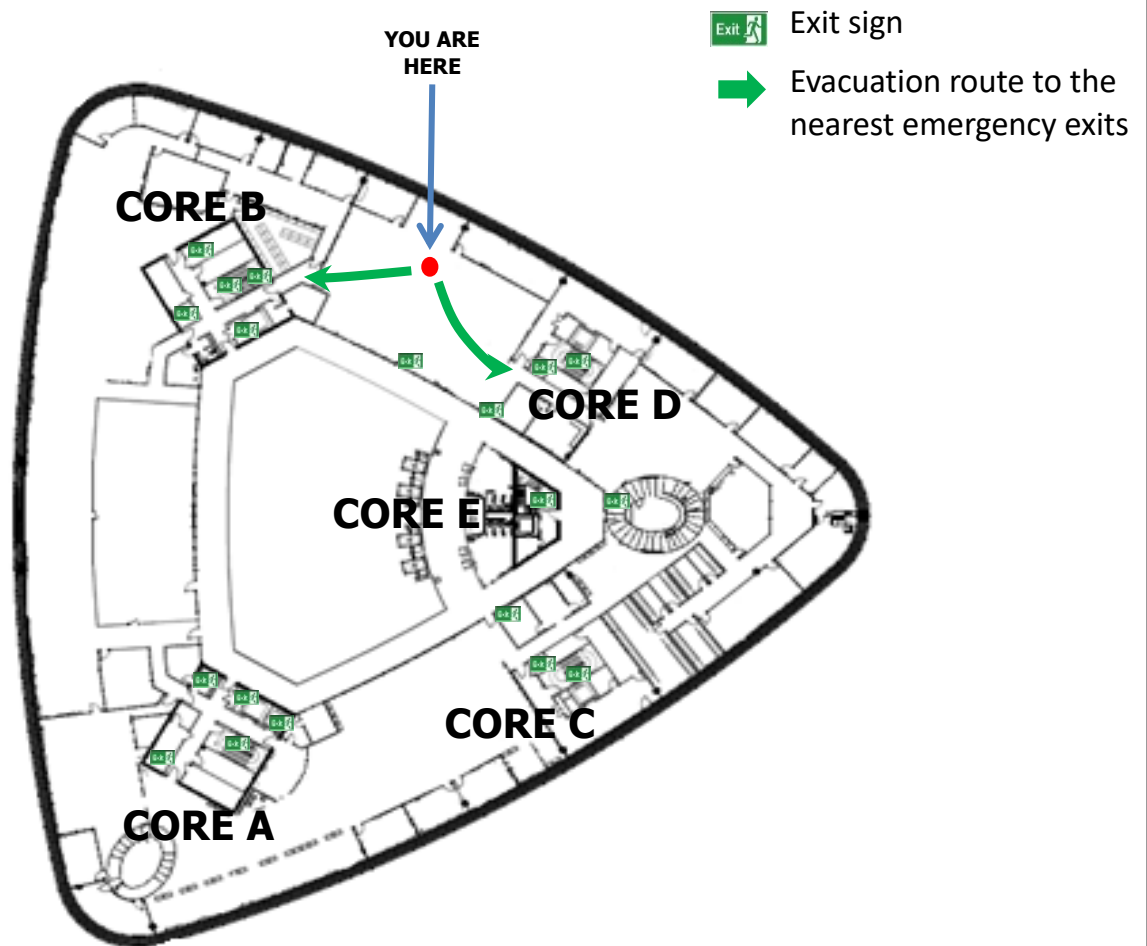
